Each year, the GLCF awards grants to local nonprofit organizations working to provide affordable housing options for our neighbors.

We are proud to partner with a variety of housing-focused organizations, which include Greater Lynchburg Habitat for Humanity, the Altavista Area/Campbell County Habitat for Humanity, Inc., the Claire Parker Foundation, and more. Together, we help local families achieve home ownership.

Rhonda Shreve, executive director of Altavista Area/Campbell County Habitat for Humanity, Inc., says that "without the support of the Greater Lynchburg Community Foundation and the local community, we could not partner with families in need to move them from substandard rental housing to safe, affordable homeownership. All of the grant money received is used to fund home builds."

These grants are made possible by generous donors who have created funds to support affordable housing for our neighbors. These funds are called "donordesignated" and "field of interest" funds, and these fund types allow the donor to direct their gift to specific causes.

Shanda Horner and her spouse Garnett recently created a new donor-designated fund to benefit the Lynchburg Humane Society at the Greater Lynchburg Community Foundation.

"In 2007, I had the good fortune and honor of being hired by Bill Quillian to work at the Greater Lynchburg Community Trust," says Shanda. "The Trust was still in its infancy, but Bill and Board Chair George Stewart felt confident enough in its potential growth to bring a paid employee on board. Bill was-and still is-my hero. His faith in, and dogged hard work for, put the Trust on the trajectory which brought it where it is today.

"After surviving the shock of my 53-year-old son's sudden death in November 2022, I wanted a way by which his kindness and generosity could live on in perpetuity. It was also important that I recognize his love for animals in some way (I lost track years ago of the number of strays he rescued)," Shanda recalls.

"The GLCF allows me to keep both his memory and his love for animals alive FOREVER. The Nicole Marschall and Rick Rowe Fund will benefit the Lynchburg Humane Socity for as long as it exists. Both Nicole, his widow, and I are so thankful for that."


