

CENTURY FUND AND FIFTY FUND GRANTS AWARDED FOR 2023

The \$100,000 Century Fund grant winner is Lynchburg Grows! Funds awarded will help transform a historic building into a multi-purpose space for community education and engagement. The selection committee lauded Lynchburg Grow's work in providing job opportunities for disabled community members and ensuring access to healthy, locally-grown food for low-income and food-insecure families in Lynchburg and surrounding counties.

The \$50,000 Fifty Fund grant winner is the Academy Center of the Arts! Funds awarded will support "Opening Minds through Art." The ACOA will soon offer this national, best-practice therapeutic intervention designed by Scripps Gerontology Center at Miami University in Ohio that promotes independence, social engagement, and self-expression among people with dementia.

The Fifty Fund grant is a one-time award created in honor of the 50th Anniversary of the Greater Lynchburg Community Foundation. Both grants were open to local nonprofits working towards transformative new programs, facilities, and impact in the greater Lynchburg area.
